Made up of a Council and an Executive Board, we **unite to grow Rotaract** in the Australiasia region.

# What is a MDIO?

## (Multi District Information Organisation)

Our main goals are:

- Connecting people that share our values with Rotaract Clubs across the Region
- Supporting clubs with resources for club administration, events and projects
- Assisting Districts with resources they can use in Club Training, advice on operations and more
- Providing National Training for our incoming District Rotaract Representatives (DRRs) every year, who form part of the RA Council
- Organising this training for you
- Uniting and fostering collaboration between members, clubs and districts by bringing people together at events like our Australian Rotaract Conference and the Australian Rotaract Games
- Recognising outstanding projects, events and members at the Rotaract Australia Award ceremony (usually held at the ARC conference)

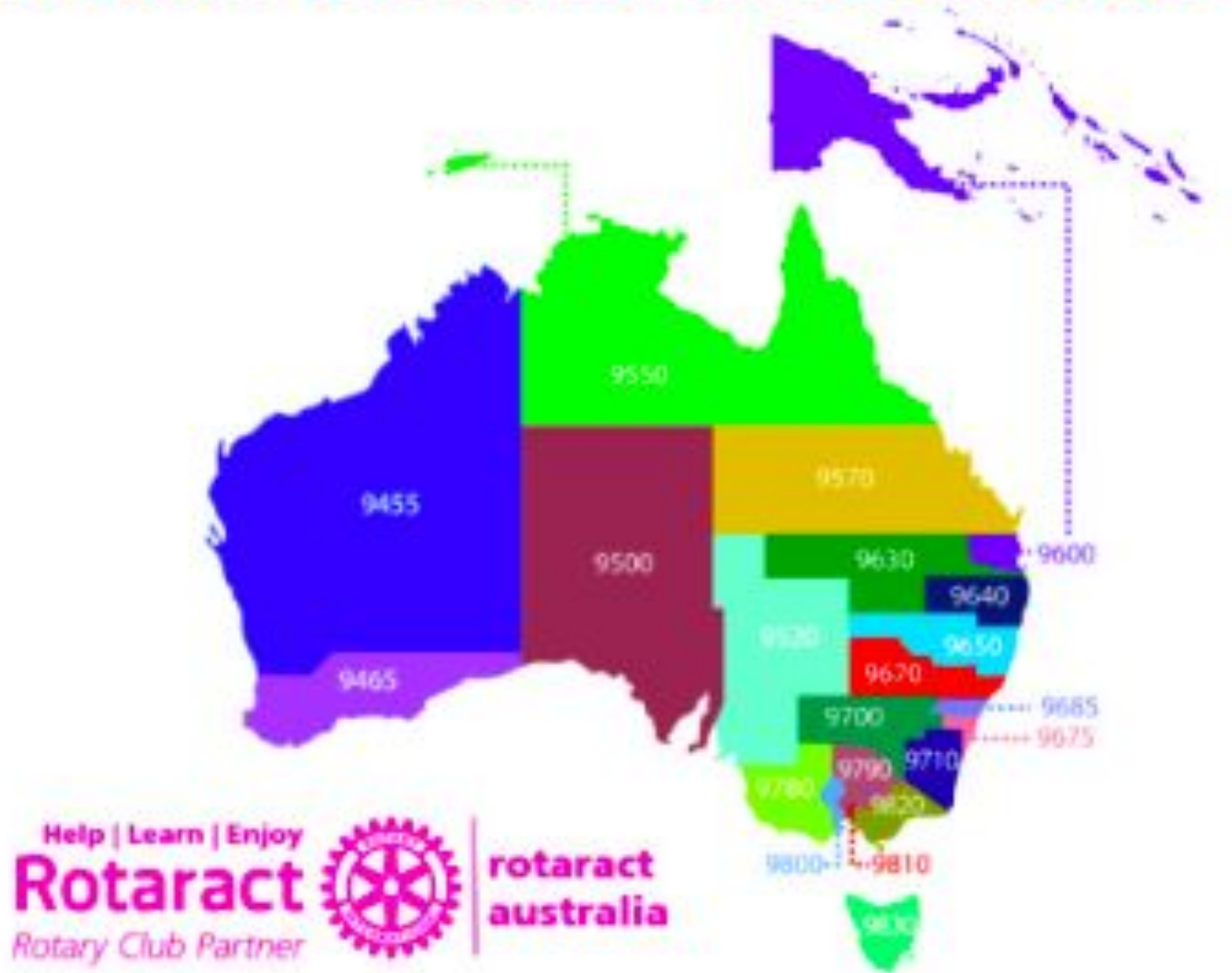

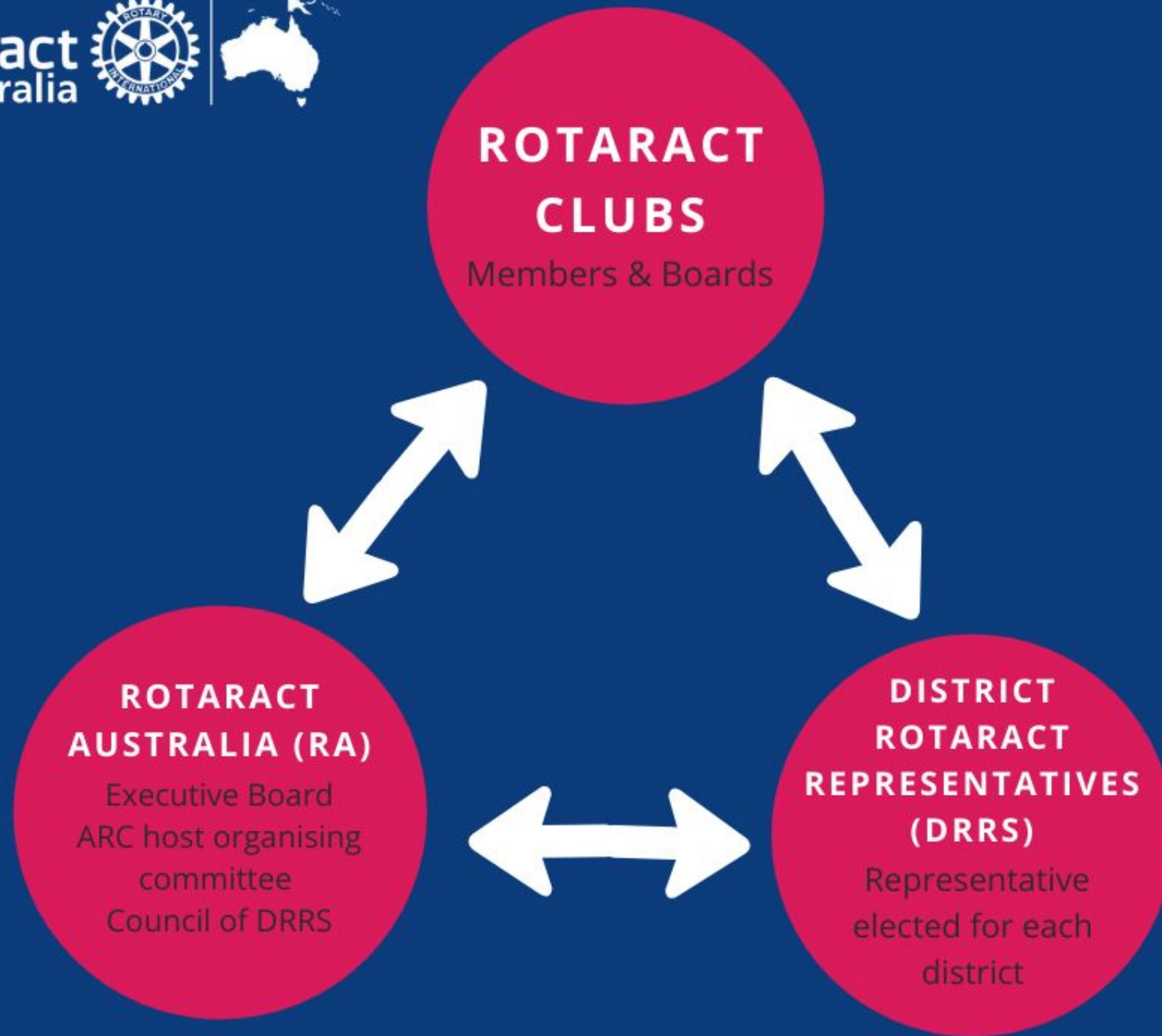
